
To whom it may concern

I would like to register an objection to the 2016-17 Legislative Council Electoral Boundaries Initial Redistribution Proposal for the following reasons;

- This proposal is a significant change with massive repercussions particularly to those in the North East and upper East Coast, who have chosen their elected member less than 12 months ago.
- The redistribution proposal put forward for comment does not support current and future community of interest and will ultimately in my view as a North East resident deliver a loss of representation in the North East and upper East Coast areas, particularly if the current member is allocated the proposed southern electorate.
- With the proposal for the Division of McIntyre, this could potentially see a re-location of the electorate office from the current Apsley electorate office based in Scottsdale. As a long term community member involved in many organisations including the Scottsdale Branch of the RSLA I am well aware of the valuable support of resources and assistance that the current member and her assistant have provided over the years.
- As a member of the Tasmanian community I have concerns around the cost of this proposed redistribution to what I consider will not enhance the democratic opportunity for Tasmanians.
